Information for patients

Lydden Surgery has been accredited as being suitable for the training of those doctors intending to become general practitioners.

This means that the practice and doctors have had to achieve a number of standards which have been assessed by Health Education Kent, Surrey and Sussex, acting on behalf of the national organisation (the Postgraduate Medical Education Board)

These are some points for your information: -

- 1) Those doctors training to become GPs are called GP Registrars. Dr Nasir of Lydden Surgery will be their GP Trainer.
- 2) The GP Registrar is a fully qualified doctor who is likely to have a lot of experience of hospital medicine.
- 3) Sometimes other doctors are also trained and supported in the practice.
- 4) If you are seeing this doctor you can expect to receive the quality of service you would from your own GP. If you have any concerns please mention this to a member of staff.
- 5) Lydden Surgery is also approved to provide a training placement for Foundation Year 2 Doctors (FY2). Foundation Year 2 Doctors are qualified Doctors who have completed one year in a hospital placement; they are registered with the GMC and spend the second year consolidating generic skills as a doctor. FY2 doctors undertake three 4 month rotations, one of which may be General Practice, supervised by Dr. Nasir.
- 6) In order for the GP Registrars to successfully complete their training they need to be assessed on their consulting skills. This is done by the appointed assessors viewing a video of the Registrar's consultations. You may be asked for your permission to have your consultation recorded in this way. The recording will be used for educational purposes only. Further information about this process and the confidentiality of it can be obtained from the reception staff.
